Hawthorn Hockey Club members Libby and Maddi Moore, who between them have roles at HHC including playing, coaching and managing, recently returned from a trip to Cambodia, where with a group of 13 high school students, they helped build a house for the Global Village Project. The HHC Under 17 girl's team donated money towards the building materials for the project and to assisting orphanages, which Libby and Maddi visited. These donations were gratefully received, thanks to the HHC Under 17 girls for their support.

Prior to leaving, Libby and Maddi collected donations of clothing, in particular underwear, from the HHC Under 9 families. The clothes were gratefully received by the children in orphanages in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap and families in a very poor village. Libby explained 'It was great to see the excitement on the kids faces when we gave out the underwear, many of the younger children ran off and returned wearing just undies, (perhaps the first they had ever owned) and a T-shirt to show us.' Thanks to the HHC Under 9 families for their support, this allowed Libby and Maddi to make a very simple, direct and personal impact on the lives of these children and families.

Whilst Libby and Maddi visited a very poor village they were told that a young lady was waiting for a doctor named Peter Lugg to arrive to perform an operation on her leg. From Hawthorn Hockey Club to Cambodia, it certainly is a small world!

This young lady indeed was waiting for Peter Lugg, President of HHC, who travels four to five times a year to Cambodia to perform and teach surgery to local doctors. Starting about ten years ago, Peter was part of a group of orthopaedic surgeons who went to Cambodia to teach trauma surgery in two hospitals in Phnom Penh. Peter was of particular assistance being able to speak some of the language and having an understanding of the culture. He has now moved onto assisting in the development of six regional hospitals, through performing surgery and teaching.

In the case of the young lady that Libby and Maddi met, she had a tumour in her lower femur which had eaten away at the bone; typically this would result in the loss of her leg. Peter performed surgery on the young lady and was able to teach local doctors a technique that removed the tumour and allowed her to retain her leg. For the first time in two years she has been able to walk again.

The Cambodians are a lovely and charming people and it is fantastic that members of the Hawthorn Hockey Club have been able to provide aid in various forms, from underwear to surgery. All of your support is greatly appreciated.

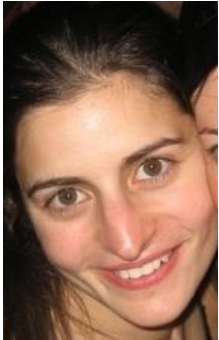
