Hawthorn Players Represent Australia



Hawthorn striker **Claire Messent** has represented Australia playing for the Hockeyroos in the recent BDO World Cup Qualifier in Santiago, Chile. The tournament offered only one place for the World Cup in August-September later this year in Rosario, Argentina. The Hockeyroos outplayed Chile, Ireland, Malaysia and Scotland to finish the tournament undefeated. During the tournament it was reported that 'striker Claire Messent...(was) brought into the team specifically to add more fire near goals'. The team now has a busy schedule preparing for the World Cup where they have been placed in the highly competitive Pool A.

As Claire was finishing up in Santiago, Hawthorn goal keeper **George Bazeley**, is also representing Australia playing for the Kookaburras in the Azlan Shah tournament in Ipoh, Malaysia. Over a month ago the Kookaburras won their first World Cup in 24 years in New Delhi, India. Of this

World Cup team only five members were included to the Azlan Shah tournament, George being one of them. On writing this article the Kookaburras had played and defeated Egypt and Malaysia and were defeated by India and in the coming days they will face Pakistan, Korea and China. WPA: Altona 1 v Hawthorn 3 Pennant A had a rough start to Saturday's game against Altona, as we were somewhat unprepared for the rough physical contest that was had. We had a few great moments in the first half with some awesome balls being sent across the attacking circle. Unfortunately we were unable to convert these so we stepped off the pitch one goal down at half time. The second half saw Pennant A step up the play right from the start. The ball movement across the field was fast and effective, enabling us to dominate the majority of play in the second half. Our defence did a great job limiting Altona's scoring opportunities, and Harry's movement and calling in the goals was fantastic, especially for her first game with us. Flick Smith scored our first goal within 10 minutes of the second half from an awesome play. Two more goals were scored as we continued to improve ball movement, speed and attacking play using long balls down the line. Special mentions must go to Zoe and Anna for their countless sprints down the field generating many short corners and chances for conversion. The second half again saw the Hawks have a lot of the attacking play with Patty "I share my hockey bag with my girlfriend" Moore hitting the post with a solid hit from the top of the circle, much to the despair of the massive crowd that stuck around in near freezing conditions. Soon after the hard work from the All Stars paid off when a short corner was awarded.
