Highlights – Rd 6

MSL1: Essendon 2 v Hawthorn 1 A tough match out at Essendon resulted in a 2-1 loss to the Hawks. The Bombers started the better team, with a couple of goal-scoring opportunities in the early stages resulting in extremely near misses. One saw Sean Jenner clear the ball off the goal-line with a good trap and clearance. Hawthorn couldn't get any flow on the slow and sticky Essendon pitch, struggling to move the ball forward with much momentum. Things started to click midway through the first half, but did not result in goals. Actually it was Essendon who put in the first score off a penalty corner conversion by Al McLennan that we knew was coming, but were powerless to save. A late goal by John Stebbings after a goal-mouth scrap with the Essendon's keeper saw the scores level at half time. The second half saw the Hawks coming out harder and taking the game by the horns. However, we could not find a way to put the ball in the net. As the umpiring descended into chaos, with Tyler Grbic being accused of flattening somebody twice his height, and a series of other bad calls, Hawthorn lost our heads somewhat and got distracted from the job at hand. About midway through the half, Essendon created a stroke, which was saved by Fred Durst in the net. But still we pushed, creating several penalty corner chances. One broken down corner led to a full field break-away from Essendon that turned into their second goal and set Hawks the task of fighting for a draw. Despite some good late charges, we couldn't pull back the much needed goal. In the end, a disappointing scoreline for the Hawks, who often struggle against Essendon, which leaves us with all the work to do against Camberwell, Doncaster and Greensborough in the last few rounds before the turn of the season. Come down to Hawthorn this weekend to see the Hawks bounce back - it's Hawthorn v Camberwell in the first leg of the Hodder-Thornton Cup at 3.30 on Saturday. Should be a good one.

WSL1: Essendon Ladies 6 v Hawthorn 3 The first 10 minutes of the game were a bit shaky, but after settling in the Hawkers really managed to put it to Essendon. The Hawkers matched their physicality and got a 2-1 lead late into the second half with Caro and Hellie scoring off some great corner variations. In the second half with about 12 minutes to play Essendon scored a debatable field goal, and momentum was their way scoring another two goals off penalty corners. At 6-2 the Hawkers kept fighting, with a great rebound shot from Anna Robinson, converting in her first SL1 match and putting in an overall great performance out on the wing. The final score was 6-3. Lots of well wishes to Georgie Ingram who had her hand broken during the game, requiring surgery the next day.

WM1N: Essendon Ladies 0 v Hawthorn(1) 3 The M1N team had a massive win in the context of the season, that sees the team move into second spot. The girls performed sensationally against a very physical Essendon team hell bent on intimidation and rough house tactics. Starting the game with only 10 players the girls absorbed the early pressure before hitting back late in the half to go in at the break 1-0 up. An early goal in the second half saw us 2-0 up before Essendon hit back through a penalty corner. A third goal after some well worked forward moves settled the matter. Some notable highlights: the Essendon "Ladies" arguing with each other on the pitch; India McKenzie making "friends" with the opposition (always good to see a junior holding her own), Holly Millar's flick setting up the third goal and last but not least Janet Davey's sterling effort in goals.

WM3N Essendon Ladies 0 v Hawthorn 1 In this hard fought encounter between two evenly matched sides, Hawthorn leave it late to take the win. The first half ebbed and flowed with both sides countering each other in the midfield and both defences were well and truly on top. There were one or two notable performances in the first period with Joan holding the ball up well against a determined Essendon defence and CC showing both determination and vision in the defence and midfield. By half time it was a stalemate with the score at nil-nil. However, towards the end of the half, Hawthorn had begun to put together a few penetrating moves that would ultimately prove a useful confidence for the second half. At the beginning of the second half it seemed that the game was going to be one of attrition right to the end. In contrast to the first half however, where much of the play seemed to be in Hawthorn's inside right corridor and down Essendon's left, the game opened up with Hawthorn using the wings to much better effect. Slowly but surely Hawthorn began to play a little more expansively with some excellent interplay and some great vision from the midfield which on a number of occasions split the Essendon defence wide open. Em Halan was having a particularly good game and there was some excellent play and penetrative runs from Liv, Rhiann and Kammy. In defence, Hawthorn looked solid and well organized. Laura in goal read the play well and made a few important interventions, including one where she seemed to go in head first to make a telling interception. It proves that you don't have to be mad to be a goalie but it helps!! For a long while it looked as though this game would end scoreless. Then the breakthrough came, with just under ten minutes to play. A speculative pass into the D from the Hawthorn midfield, left the goalie unsighted. The last gasp attempt to stop the ball only resulted in it being left loose and perilously close to the goal line. While the goalie made a real attempt to make amends for her error, after a scramble that seemed to take an age, the ball was finally forced over the line by Kammy. Essendon had the lion's share of the last five minutes and while the team was visibly tiring, Hawthorn's defence held firm. In a nail-biting finale the team survived an after the whistle penalty corner to win one-nil. On the whole, Hawthorn deserved to win - they fought hard and played together well as a team with everyone making a great contribution – well done ladies!! 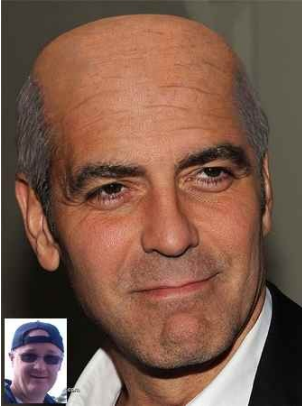

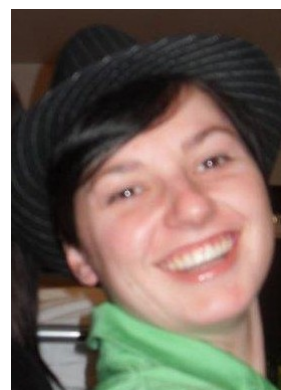
